‘Public Enemies’ Economic Breakdown

IATSE Local #470 based in Oshkosh, was responsible for providing labor during the pre-production, production and post production phases of Universal Films ‘Public Enemies’.

Pre-production began on Tuesday, March 25<sup>th</sup> 2008 and is estimated to continue through Wednesday April 23<sup>rd</sup>. The rates run from \$20.07 to \$27.17 an hour, with average wage being \$22.43 an hour. Overtime is applicable after 8 hours in a day and double time after 12 hours. Average daily hours being put in by workers are 11.5. There are also benefits being paid that total \$65.00 per day per person. The rates and conditions were covered under the nationally recognized Area Standards Agreement of 2006.

The wages in Oshkosh to date including future estimates for post production totals \$345,397.22 with additional benefits totaling \$74, 555.00. Bringing overall wage/benefit estimates to \$419,952.22.

Some of the areas covered by our people (IATSE 470) include set construction, metal fabrication, scenic painting, general labor, carpentry, special effects, plastering, wardrobe, utilities, makeup, and grips (electrics).

To say that this was a positive economic experience would be an understatement. To place it in perspective; in 2007 our total payroll revenues brushed 2 million dollars for the entire year. In 5 weeks we have achieved over 20% of that total with this single production.
